BORN A PRINCESS

Queen Victoria was born in Kensington Palace on May 24, 1819 and was given two names Alexandrina Victoria. She was named after her godfather, Tsar Alexander I, the Emperor of Russia, and after her mother. Queen Victoria's father was Edward, the Duke of Kent and her mother was Princess Victoria of Germany.

F (0) While growing up, she was called by the nickname 'Drina. Spending most of her days with private teachers and playing with dolls, she had little contact with other children when she was young. As she grew older she enjoyed painting, drawing, and writing in her diary.

HEIR TO THE CROWN

When Victoria was born, she was fifth in line for the crown of England. _____ (1) However, after several of her uncles failed to have children, she became first in line as heir to the crown. When Victoria was told – she was 13 years old at that time – that she would some day be Queen, she said "I will be good."

BECOMING QUEEN

When King William IV died in 1837, Victoria became Queen of the United Kingdom. She was only 18. Her official coronation took place on June 28, 1838.

_____ (2) She was determined to be a good queen and the people liked her from the start. She ruled the country for 63 years.

Marrying a Prince

On October 10, 1839 a German Prince named Albert came to visit the royal court. Victoria immediately fell in love with him. Five days later, they were engaged to be married. _____ (3)

THE VICTORIAN ERA

The time when Queen Victoria ruled the United Kingdom was a period of prosperity and peace for the country. It was the time of the world's first Industrial Revolution, the time when the first modern railroad line opened, the time of the first telephone and telegraph.

ALBERT'S DEATH

On December 14, 1861 Albert died from typhoid fever. Queen Victoria went into a deep depression and withdrew from all politics. There was one point at which many people questioned her ability to rule the country. But after a certain period of time, Victoria recovered and began to take a strong interest in the British Empire and its colonies. She took particular interest in India and became Empress of India.

GRANDMOTHER OF EUROPE

Queen Victoria is often called the Grandmother of Europe because so many of Europe's monarchs are her relatives. Her first son, Edward, became king after her and married a princess from Denmark. Her daughter Victoria, the Princess Royal, married the Emperor of Germany.

Queen Victoria had thirty-seven great-grandchildren at the time of her death on January 22, 1901.
